Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They began as a small machine shop at first hiring four individuals. Sales for their first year of operation amounted to about \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and different components. During 5 years of operation, the company had stretched to 40 workers and their annual sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. At present, Cascade is one of the top global makers in the material handling business.

Manufacture and design of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of new business opportunities. During the past 60 years, the material handling trade has matured into a very sophisticated area and Cascade has proudly played a part in this growth. Cascade presently continues to grow as the leader supplier of forklift attachments and various associated items. The business feels confident in their capability to be able to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's needs in the future and remaining aggressive in the international market.

In the 1950's, Cascade started designing, manufacturing and advertising hydraulic attachments. Manufacturing was finished in the year 1956 on a new office to be able to accommodate all the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current center of operations. Subsequent to 15 years of business, total staff reached 180 employees and sales had reached nearly \$2,300,000.

The next manufacturing plant was built in 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. The year 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary move into the international world of the material handling industry while the business established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

The company changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. The business has expanded its production plants throughout the United States with places in Portland, Oregon, Springfield, Ohio, and Warner Robins, Georgia. Cascade merchandise are fabricated globally because of a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This plant is designed to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 after buying 5 corporations, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global best in blades.
